We should go back and grasp O'Donnell latest work.
Democracy in a global world, after the 2008 crisis.
Crisis arrived very late in O'Donnell's life
for him. It was impossible for him, to get
~~great~~ conclusions for the humans that
the crisis has produced in neoliberal ideas.

Politics is back; public policies are back;
A new powerful landscape emerges in front of us.
In Latin America it has been the end of a long
cycle, from dictatorship - to transitions, to
rather weak + imperfect democracies.
But Lat Am is different; our economies
revisited the crisis; financial system OK.
Poverty is being reduced, (China thank you)
but not.
